- 3. COMPATIBLE SPEAKER CABINETS FOR P.A. SYSTEM, adequate for venue. Please note, our audience is expecting folk/light rock music, not heavy metal.
- 4. (5) STAGE MONITORS, with minimum of 4 mixes
- 5. (6) SHURE SM 58 MICROPHONES WITH BOOM STANDS AND CABLES
- 6. (1) COUNTRYMAN HEADSET WIRELESS MICROPHONE
- APPROPRIATE MICROPHONES FOR DRUMS/PERCUSSION
